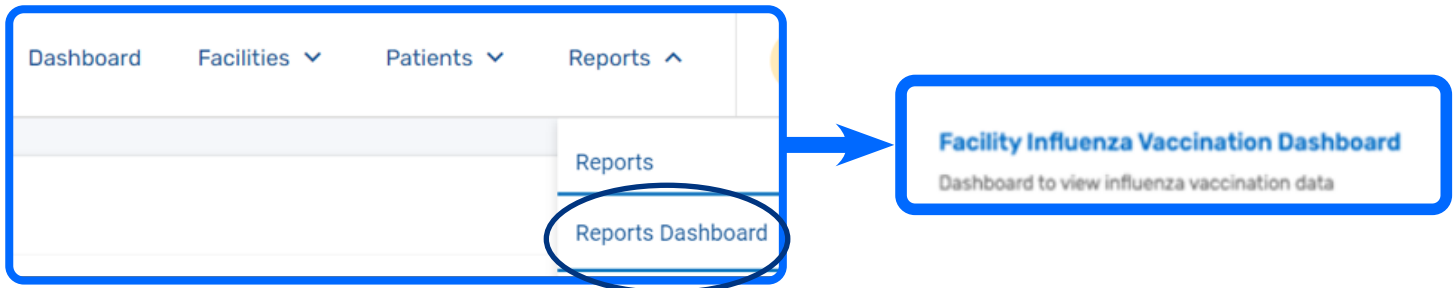


# Influenza Vaccination Dashboard

1. After logging into EQRS, click **Reports Dashboards** from the Reports drop-down tab in the navigation menu.
2. Select the **Facility Influenza Vaccination Dashboard**.



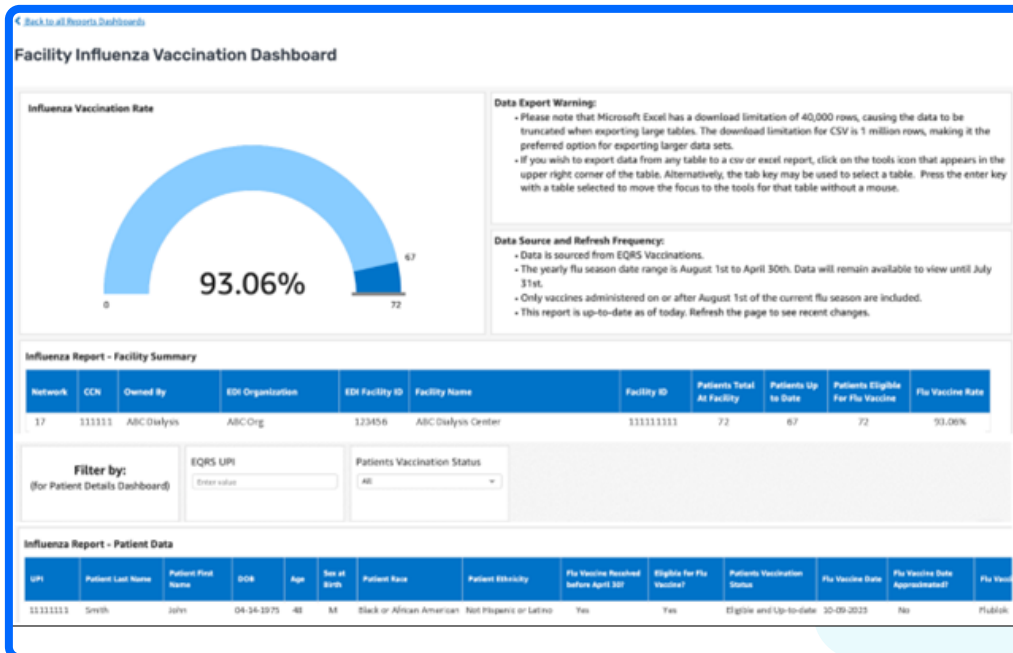
## Important Details:

- Data is sourced from EQRS Vaccinations.
- The yearly flu season date range is August 1 to April 30. Data will remain available to view until July 31.
- Only vaccines administered on or after August 1 of current flu season are included.

## Facility Summary Report

- Displays facility Influenza vaccination information for the yearly flu season (August 1-April 30)
- Displays the number of patients that are up to date on their flu vaccine, are eligible for a flu vaccine, and the influenza vaccination rate in the facility.



## Data Refresh Frequency:

This report is up to date as of the day you view it. Refresh the page to see recent changes.

## Patient Details Report

- Displays patient influenza vaccination information entered in EQRS including:
  - Vaccination status
  - Vaccination date and name (if specified)
- Filter by EQRS Unique Patient Identifier or Patient's Vaccination Status, if desired.

## View Inclusion/Exclusion criteria.

**Inclusion Criteria:**

- Prevalent patients receiving dialysis aged 19 and older.
- Dialysis facilities that are currently open and certified and have a provider type of "Medicare".
- Patients are attributed to the facility where they most recently dialyzed – the vaccination record follows the patient.

**Exclusion Criteria:**

- Patients under the age of 19.
- Patients not receiving dialysis.
- Patients with Medical Reason – Allergic or Adverse Reaction reported unless they are fully vaccinated.
- Patients with Declined – Religious Philosophical reason reported unless they are fully vaccinated.

## Exported Dashboard Reports

Download reports via the Export to CSV or Export to Excel buttons. CSV is the preferred option for large files.
