Get in the **KNOW** About Pneumo Vaccines!

- 1) **Pneumococcal disease** remains a burden among adults. Studies suggest that the pneumonia-related mortality rate in chronic kidney disease (CKD) could be as much as 14-16 times higher compared to the general population.

Available NOW is the PCV 20, which is one and done! One shot with more protection to keep your patients healthy.

- 2) There are **4** recommended pneumococcal vaccines in the U.S.

PCV15

PCV20

PCV21

PPSV23

CDC recommends **PCV15, PCV20, or PCV21** for all adults 50 years or older:

- Who have never received a PCV
- Whose previous vaccination history is unknown

If PCV 15 is used:

- An additional dose of PPSV23 is needed.

Patients 19-49 years with immunocompromising conditions such as chronic kidney failure are recommended to receive pneumococcal vaccines.
