Pfizer vs. Moderna Vaccines

Both Vaccines

- 94 to 95 percent effective
- Need two doses
- Use new technology called mRNA
- Do not impact your body's DNA (genetic material)
- Are not a live virus vaccine
- Side effects include:
 - mild fever
 - headache
 - fatigue
 - pain at the injection site

Pfizer

- Second shot 21 days after the first
- For people 16 and older

Vs

Moderna

- Second shot 28 days after the first
- For people 18 and older
