Up-to-Date NHSN Vaccine Reporting



The "Up to Date" status for COVID-19 vaccination in the National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN) changed December 30, 2024.

People age 65 and older, or those who are immunocompromised, are up to date with two doses of the 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccine (or one dose within the past six months).

Individuals younger than 65 are up to date with one dose of the 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccine

A resident with a newly positive COVID-19 test result is counted in the up-to-date category if they received the vaccine at least 14 days before the positive test.

The 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccine was approved in August 2024. Refer to CDC's Staying Up to Date with COVID-19 Vaccines for details.

NHSN Reporting Information

If an individual is eligible to receive a 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccine, but has not received it, they are NOT "Up to Date" with COVID-19 vaccination.

If you realize you have incorrectly entered data for resident or staff vaccinations, you may adjust your recent counts for that question.
