<p>If the last accepted assessment for the quarter meets the definition of the numerator, the resident will flag for that quarter.</p> <p>If the last accepted assessment does not meet the definition of the numerator, the resident will not flag for that quarter.</p>	<p>This QM will flag for at least 275 days (3 calendar quarters).</p> <p>If you don't complete a minimum data set (MDS) before the end of the calendar quarter that is at least 276 days after the MDS that captured the Fall/Fall with Injury, this QM will flag for 4 calendar quarters.</p> <p>Important to understand your dates to remove after 3 quarters.</p> <p>If the resident discharges, the calendar quarter in which the resident discharged will be the last quarter the resident will flag for this.</p>	<p>Short-stay measures have a 6-month lookback.</p> <p>Residents will flag for 2 calendar quarters (6 months) for this QM.</p>	<p>If the last accepted assessment for the quarter meets the definition of the numerator, the resident will flag for that quarter.</p> <p>If the last accepted assessment does not meet the definition of the numerator, the resident will not flag for that quarter.</p>	<p>Short-stay measures have a 6-month lookback.</p> <p>Residents will flag for 2 calendar quarters (6 months) for this QM.</p>	<p>If a resident is flagging for this QM, they had an inhouse aquired p/u or worsened p/u during a MCR A stay.</p> <p>Completing a new MDS will not make this QM fall off.
