Vocational Rehabilitation Services help to determine what services you need. They provide:

- Guidance in choosing suitable employment
- Individual counseling from a vocational rehab case manager
- Physical or mental restoration services to help you gain employment
- Transportation costs, as needed, to participate in rehab services
- Assistive devices that increase your ability to work
- Vocational training to prepare you for employment (may include assistance with school costs or on the job training)
- Job related tools/licenses
- Help in developing job seeking skills
- Assistance in finding a job
